Vienna Theatre Company presents “Doubt, A Parable”

It’s opening night for “Doubt, A Parable” presented by the Vienna Theatre Company. This Pulitzer Prize and Tony Award-winning story casts suspicion on a priest’s behavior in a Catholic school in the Bronx in the 1960s.

The play explores principal Sister Aloysius’s suspicions about an inappropriate relationship between a priest, Father Flynn, and an altar boy in a story that is less about scandal than about nuanced questions of moral certainty. Though it’s never clear if Sister Aloysius is actually in the right, the possibility that she could be right about Father Flynn demonstrates that acting morally may mean prioritizing large-scale ethical convictions over smaller concerns about what’s right and what’s wrong.

The Vienna Theatre Company’s performances of “Doubt, A Parable” are at 8 p.m. on the following Fridays and Saturdays: Oct. 21-22, Oct. 28-29 and Nov. 4-5. Matinee performances begin at 2 p.m. on Sundays, Oct. 30 and Nov. 6. Tickets are \$15.
