Robbery Update

Vienna, Virginia - On June 2, 2023, the Vienna Police responded to a robbery involving a postal carrier on his route on Church Street Northeast. The victim reported being assaulted with pepper spray and having postal property stolen.

Subsequent to the initial incident, a series of thefts occurred, targeting blue collection boxes in the Vienna, Fairfax, and Oakton areas. In response, Vienna PD initiated a collaborative investigation with the U.S. Postal Inspection Service.

Vienna Police Detectives successfully identified two suspects, a juvenile and a 19-year-old, believed to be connected to the robbery and the subsequent mail thefts.

Today, a coordinated effort involving Vienna Police Detectives, Fairfax County SWAT, and the U.S. Postal Inspection Service led to the execution of a search warrant in the 3000 block of Borge Street in Oakton, VA.

Both suspects were apprehended without incident. Charges include robbery, assault with a caustic substance, and identity theft. The investigation remains ongoing.
