## Assignments Set for New Vienna Town Council

It's down to business for the new Vienna Town Council. At its first regular meeting of the new term of Monday, Jan. 8, 2024, the Mayor and Council established leadership roles for the coming two years.

Incumbent Councilmember Chuck Anderson will serve as Mayor Pro Tempore through 2024, and newly elected Councilmember Jessica Ramakis will serve in that role in 2025, the second year of the Council's two-year term.

The new panel was sworn in on Jan. 2, 2024, after an historic election that put all seats on the November 2023 ballot for the first time ever. Prior to that election, the Mayor and Council elections were held in May on a staggered, two-year-term basis. The election cycle was moved after a change in Virginia election laws requiring all municipal elections to be placed on the November General Election ballot.
