Vienna Celebrates Spring with the Walk on the Hill

Some of the town's most beautiful, historic properties will be featured during this year's Walk on the Hill, Sunday, April 28 from 2-5 p.m. in the Windover Heights neighborhood. Since 1974, residents and visitors have made the lovely pilgrimage to this historic neighborhood to participate in self-guided tours through dozens of participating yards and gardens offering inspiring views of glorious spring flowers, budding trees, live music, exhibits and refreshments.

Some of this year's special exhibits include a flower show presented by District III of the National Capital Area Garden Clubs at Green Hedges School, "**If This House Could Talk...**" signs describing historic and fun information about some of the homes in participating yards, and an historic exhibit and tours at Salisbury Spring Park.

The event along Windover Avenue between Lewis Street and Lawyers Road is free and is presented as a partnership between the Town of Vienna, Historic Vienna, Inc., and the Windover Heights Historic District.
